A new **non-HREC Ethics & Governance Review Request Form** is now available.

We've made important updates to the form including:

- Revised section 5.3 Internal and External Support
- Section 6: Declarations and Signatures
 - Additional requirements for Principal Investigators
 - Addition of signature block for Head of Supporting Department.

To ensure a smooth transition, a grace period is in place until 28 February 2025. During this time, both old and new forms will be accepted.
